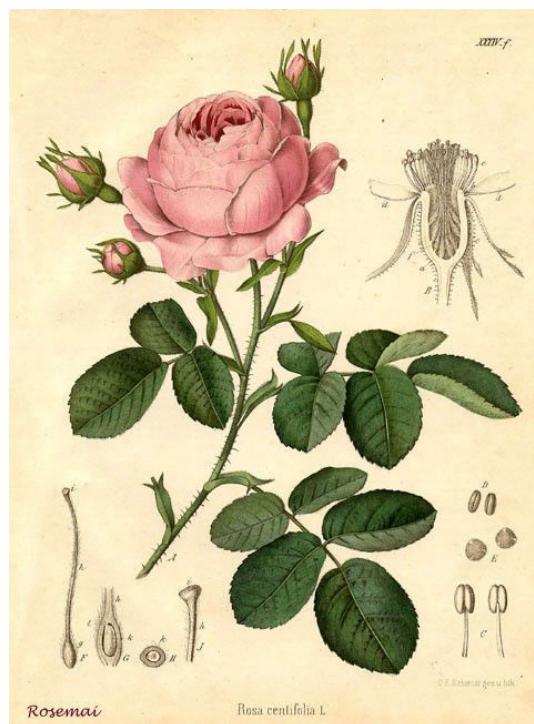


## BioGuano Program for Roses

**Roses are hardy perennials that like a fertile, well-drained soil and will grow best in protected spots with ample water and full sun for at least 6 hours a day. Roses are always hungry but if you feed them well they'll produce glorious blooms.**

Choosing a BioGuano liquid fertiliser maintenance program will reward you with spectacular blooms and healthy foliage.

### Simple Tips for Great Roses:

Feed your roses regularly during periods of active growth. And when growth slows in the cooler months, continue to feed the soil with the right minerals for hardy plants and to encourage beneficial soil biology.

Add quality compost in late winter and freshen the mulch around each rose to stop weeds and retain soil moisture. If transplanting bare-rooted roses, drench the roots in a BioGuano+ solution after planting to settle the soil and support new root growth.

Roses love lucerne mulch and it adds valuable nutrients to the soil over time. Mulching around roses preserves soil moisture and keeps roots and biology at a constant temperature. It also controls weed seedlings and acts as a barrier to disease spores from the soil.

In spring, your roses will need moderate nitrogen and a good supply of phosphorus, calcium, magnesium and potassium to start initiating and building strong flower buds. BioGuano liquid fertilisers incorporate seaweed and humates in the program to stimulate the root system and reduce heat and moisture stress and better tolerance of pest and disease pressure.

Roses thrive in full sun, so select a location that receives at least six hours of direct sunlight daily. Ensure the soil is well-draining to prevent waterlogged roots. Incorporate compost or well-rotted manure to improve soil structure, fertility, and drainage.
